**UN-Energy Side Event:  
UN-Energy and system-wide approach to climate change**

---

UN-Energy was established to help ensure coherence in the UN system's multi-disciplinary response to the World Summit on Sustainable Development (WSSD) and to ensure the effective engagement of non-UN stakeholders in implementing WSSD energy-related decisions. Its aim is to promote system-wide collaboration in the area of energy with a coherent and consistent approach since there is no single entity in the UN system that has primary responsibility for energy. The group focuses on substantive and collaborative actions both in regard to policy development in the energy area and its implementation, as well as in maintaining an overview of major ongoing initiatives within the system, based on the UN-Energy work programme at global, regional sub-regional and national levels. The Johannesburg Plan of Implementation (JPOI), decisions taken at CSD-9, the Programme for the Further Implementation of Agenda 21, and Agenda 21 serve as the basis for action on energy.

The UN-Energy Side event is organized as an interactive round table, where representatives from UN Agencies that are members of UN-Energy will provide input on how UN-Energy can support the Secretary-General's strategy for climate change. The issue of bioenergy will be used as an example around which to focus the Round Table's discussions.

The UN-Energy Side Event will be held from 13:00 to 15:00 at Aston Bali Hotel and will be announced in the *Daily Programme* of the events for Thursday, 13 December 2007. It will be co-chaired by Mr. K. Yumkella, Director-General of UNIDO, who chair UN-Energy for the next biennium, and Mr. Zukang Sha, Under Secretary-General for Economic and Social Affairs. Former Republic of Korea Foreign Minister and General Assembly President and a Special Envoy for Climate Change, Mr. Han Seung-soo will deliver a keynote statement on
