

**6<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the GBEP Technical Working Group**

**19 March 2010**

The 5<sup>th</sup> Technical Working Group (Paris, 9-10 July 2009) agreed that the programme of work of the proposed new GBEP Task Force on the deployment of technologies for sustainable bioenergy was valuable and relevant to GBEP's mandate. Despite the lack of human resources from Partners and Observers, that was seen as the major obstacle to undertaking significant work in the new area and to establishing a new Task Force immediately, the Chair suggested to focus on Phase 1 of the proposed programme of work for the time being, and to identify within this phase the tasks that could be started (Task 1, 3 and 4).

The 8<sup>th</sup> Steering Committee (Jakarta, 18 November 2009), while recognizing that technology deployment was the logical next step for GBEP, requested further discussion on the draft scope and programme of work. Partners and Observers were invited to send comments to the Secretariat in order to modify the current draft with a view to discussing it in March at the next meeting of the Technical Working Group.

The aim of the 6<sup>th</sup> TWG meeting (The Hague, 19 March 2010) is to discuss a new draft and programme of work for a new GBEP Task Force and make recommendations to the Steering Committee for its decision.
