Workshop on the Implementation Guide for the GBEP Sustainability Indicators for Bioenergy

PRELIMINARY AGENDA

The GBEP Task Force on Sustainability (TFS) is working to enhance the practicality of the GBEP Sustainability Indicators for Bioenergy (GSI) by producing an Implementation Guide to complement its GSI report. In this context, in 2017 progress has been made in the development of a **technical report on Attribution** and of a **technical paper on the relation between SDGs and GSIs**, as kind contributions by the German Government.

The technical report on Attribution aims to highlight the attribution of impacts to bioenergy production and use, while the technical paper will highlight the relation between SDGs and GSIs and will determine how they may be mutually reinforcing. As a contribution to and support towards the development of this latter paper, a GBEP international workshop was organized in Bonn on 3-4 July 2017 to further discuss the importance of the linkages between SDGs and GSIs.

This workshop in Rome represents the opportunity to further discuss the status of the development of the Implementation Guide, with particular reference to these two streams of work.
