Overview

In the last two decades, both production and consumption of liquid biofuels increased 11-fold, driven by public policies that incentivize uptake. With growing demand for biofuels, biomass supply also needs to keep pace, taking into account competing uses of biomass. Innovative practices in biomass production can help to increase supply whilst ensuring sustainability.

This webinar will discuss best practices in bioenergy crops in terms of regenerative farming and will also present mechanization options for improving biomass production whilst maintaining social benefits of bioenergy production such as jobs.
