Management and disposal of wastes is a major global problem. Anaerobic digestion offers opportunities not only to minimise waste volumes but also to recover embodied energy in the form of biogas and biomethane.

This webinar will look at policy incentives that are available to increase the installation of biogas plants in Europe and provide a case study from France. Furthermore, the webinar will present a methodology for understanding the replicability of national policies so that the discussion can focus on the application of these practical and policy cases in other regions.
